Hybrid energy solutions for Bainbridge Island

To continue to provide safe and reliable power to Bainbridge Island, Puget Sound Energy will upgrade the island's electric infrastructure with a hybrid solutions package, including traditional wire and non-wire solutions and new technologies.

Over the last few years, PSE informed and engaged the community on several electric projects. Together, these projects create a [hybrid solutions package](#) that will improve electric reliability and capacity on Bainbridge Island. The following are part of the overall hybrid solutions for the island:

- [Murden Cove – Winslow 115 kV transmission line](#). PSE plans to build a new transmission line between the Murden Cove and Winslow substations, creating a transmission loop. With the new transmission line, each substation on Bainbridge Island will be connected to two transmission lines. If one line goes out, the other line will still feed the substation and provide power to customers.
- [Winslow Tap transmission rebuild](#). PSE will replace aging poles and equipment, install new lines, improve access and reduce the number of trees falling into the lines, and provide safer access in this challenging terrain. This work will result in more reliable power with shorter outages to more than 3,500 customers in the south end of the island.
- [Battery Energy Storage System](#). This 3.3 MW battery will provide more energy to customers when short-term demand is high, such as on cold winter mornings. As a “peak-shaving” battery, it will charge when electricity demand is low and provide energy during peak demand times. We currently plan to locate this battery in the existing Murden Cove substation site. This project will be PSE’s largest utility-scale battery and could serve as a model for other battery projects in the region.
- Targeted conservation and demand response programs. To help solve the island’s distribution capacity issues and postpone a substation, we plan to work with the community to lower customer demand. This includes partnering with customers to both lower their energy use during peak demand times and implement energy efficiency measures. More information to come!

Currently, we’re conducting fieldwork, engineering, real estate planning, and permitting for these projects. Together with Bainbridge Island customers, we’ll improve reliability, ensure we can meet the community’s energy needs and create a better energy future. We’re committed to keeping the community informed of our progress on this critical hybrid solutions package.

We strongly recommend getting multiple bids on your solar project and checking references before selecting an installer.

Remember, there's no hurry to install solar at your home. PSE's offering of net metering – which helps you offset the cost of the electricity you buy with energy you generate at home – will likely remain in place through at least 2023 as it's governed by state law. And, we'll be working to determine how net metering can continue into the future to keep supporting our customers' needs.

Bainbridge Island Land Trust

Watersheds, stream corridors, and wetlands provide habitat for an incredibly diverse array of fish and wildlife, which are critical to our island community. Intact, healthy watersheds provide groundwater recharge and protect us from increased flooding due to climate change. “We have over 47 miles of streams here on the Island, and the Bainbridge Island

A step towards achieving this goal was the protection of the beautiful 23-acre Springbrook Creek Preserve in 2019. Springbrook Creek is home to many fish species including cutthroat trout, sculpin, lamprey, and coho and chum salmon. This nearly 1,000-acre watershed is designated as critical habitat for Puget Sound steelhead. The Land Trust-led restoration of this important stream corridor will ripple past the shores of Bainbridge Island to support salmon and orca in Puget Sound.

At the same time, their Stand for the Land campaign (which has protected over 120 acres since 2017) is still actively safeguarding natural areas across the Island. In early 2022, the wildlife-rich 35-acre Rockaway Bluff Preserve was expanded to a total of 45 acres with the addition of wetlands and a seasonal stream. Most recently, the Land Trust is working to permanently protect the 10 acres immediately north of Miller-Kirkman Preserve near Manzanita Bay. This preserve encompasses the brackish estuary of Manzanita Creek, a vital salmon stream for the region, and these new 10 acres hold a rich wetland complex that provides ample room for young salmon to grow into strong, healthy adults. Housing Resources Bainbridge Community Land Trust expands and celebrates

With the acquisition of 31 units at the upcoming [Wintergreen Townhomes](#) on Bainbridge Island, [Housing Resources Bainbridge](#) (HRB) will expand its inventory of affordable homes for ownership by 70%. These homes will join the HRB community land trust, where they will be kept affordable forever for income-eligible households. Today, at \$369,000, they are well under market rate for Bainbridge, and as time passes and real estate prices continue to rise, these homes will become even more affordable—a testament to the effectiveness of the community land trust model which restricts resale prices while still allowing the seller to build equity.
