Beginning fieldwork for Murden Cove -Winslow 115kV Line Project

This summer, surveyors will start fieldwork along the selected transmission line route for the <u>Murden Cove – Winslow 115 kV Transmission Line Project</u>. This fieldwork will inform PSE's project design and permit documentation. PSE will notify adjacent property owners as the work proceeds. Please let us know if you have questions – thank you.

Testing battery storage for businesses at PSE's Poulsbo Service Center

We are testing new energy technology – like battery storage – to reduce the demand for power and transition to a clean energy future for all. To meet the needs of commercial customers, PSE is testing a commercial battery storage project at our Poulsbo Service Center. In October 2019, we installed this behind-the-meter 30kW battery in a weather-proof cabinet on a concrete foundation in the service center's parking lot. We tested the battery to see how it operates in all four seasons, and to see how effectively it can mitigate demand charges. The results indicate that batteries can be a useful tool for saving on monthly electricity bills, particularly for buildings with large, short peaks in electricity consumption. 
Sounds of Summer Concert Series at Battle Point Park - Free!
