Investing in electric reliability and grid modernization - project updates

Electric reliability on the island needs to be improved. In finding solutions, PSE committed to exploring new technologies. Our proposed plan is a unique solution designed for Bainbridge Island – combining new technologies and grid infrastructure to ensure safe, dependable power for families and businesses for years to come. We will partner with the community to implement these solutions.

Winslow Tap transmission pole replacements

You may recall, PSE announced plans in 2019

line. The Winslow Tap line is the only line the serves the Winslow substation, which serves 3,500 customers in the south end. The transmission line was built in the 1960s and its equipment is nearing the end of useful life and needs to be replaced.



The fieldwork we conducted this summer revealed that some of the existing poles and equipment need to be replaced sooner than we had anticipated.

In late September, we began replacing specific poles and equipment to ensure continued safety and electric reliability. Crews have made significant progress and are on track to complete the work this fall. We appreciate the impacted community's flexibility during construction, which allowed crews to prioritize completion of this work before storm season picks up.

Work continues on the design of the overall Winslow Tap rebuild project, which will replace aging infrastructure and improve safety and access so we can continue to serve customers reliably into the future. Update on the "missing link" transmission line community engagement

As part of our solution to improve reliability on the island, we're planning to build the "missing link" transmission line between the Murden Cove and Winslow substations. This year, we launched a community engagement process to help inform our routing process for a new transmission line to improve electric reliability on Bainbridge Island.

We've had multiple meetings with the Community Sounding Board (CSB) to gather input and feedback on the routing process and routing criteria, as well as providing insights into the transmission line project need and the other investments PSE is making in reliability and grid modernization on the island.

We've also hosted two information sessions with industry experts on topics we heard people had questions about, such as undergrounding power lines. Slides and notes from previous meetings are available on our website: <u>psebainbridge.participate.online</u>.
